# **KEY QUESTION:**

#### GAME: WOULD YOU RATHER

#### WHAT YOU NEED:

- No supplies needed.

### ACTIVITIES:

GAME: WOULD YOU RATHER CRAFT: THE ANGEL FAMILY DEVO MEMORY VERSE

### **CRAFT: THE ANGEL**

### WHAT YOU NEED:

 Angel Activity sheet, coloring supplies, glue, cotton balls, scissors, magnet, popsicle stick
Optional: glitter glue, googly eyes, ribbon, stapler

### **DESCRIPTION:**

Watch the KP Online XP.

- Print activity sheet and cut angel out
- Allow child to draw a face, add googly eyes if available
- Add glitter glue and attach cotton balls to bottom of angel to represent clouds, or color
- Cut a two inch piece of ribbon, wrap around the head and staple the back to the head so the front is slightly lifted off of the angels head OR you can cut out the halo provided on activity sheet (p. 2) and glue it on
- Add magnet to the back and place on fridge.

#### RECAP: THE ANGEL AND MARY

**STORYTELLER:** "Today's Bible story started long ago when God sent an angel to a girl named Mary. Mary was surprised and afraid when she saw the angel. But the angel said, 'Do not be afraid, Mary. God wants you to know that you are going to have a baby! His name will be Jesus. He will be very special because Jesus is God's Son!' When Mary heard this amazing news, she told the angel that she would do what God wanted her to do. And that is the beginning of the true story of Christmas. An angel told Mary that God was giving us a very special gift, His very own Son, Jesus! God gave us Jesus because He loves us so much!"

### QUESTIONS:

- 1. Who told Mary she was having a baby?
- 2. Why is Mary's baby special?
- 3. Why did God give us His son, Jesus?
