

CRAFT- FIREWORKS

WHAT YOU NEED: ACTIVITY SHEET, PAINT DABBERS, MARKERS WHAT YOU DO:

- Print an activity sheet
- Allow your child to use the paint dab markers or paint and a paint brush to dab the circles to create colorful fireworks
- They may use the markers to trace over the lines and and decorate the rest of the page

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Today is the 4th of July! A day to celebrate our country. So for today's craft, we are going to make fireworks."

2 YEAR OLDS-KINDERGARTEN WEEK 2 CRAFT- WALKING ON WATER


WHAT YOU NEED: STAR STICKERS, POPSICLE STICKS, PETER AND JESUS CUT OUT, GLUE, BLUE WAVE CUTOUT, STAPLER

WHAT YOU DO:

- Print the activity page. Cut along the center dotted line. Cut out the pictures of Peter and Jesus.
- Encourage your child to color.
- Staple the waves at the sides only onto the bottom of the activity page..
- Help your child glue the cut out men to their popsicle sticks.
- Encourage them to place the star stickers in the night sky.
- Place the popsicle sticks in between the paper and the wave to demonstrate the Bible story

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Peter trusted Jesus, so he walked out onto the water, in the middle of the storm, to meet Jesus. That is incredible! Who can trust God? I can trust God!"







Use the top half of the page as the activity page. Cut along the dotted lines to cut out Peter and Jesus and the waves.



CRAFT- ARMOR OF GOD

WHAT YOU NEED: ACTIVITY SHEET, ARMOR PIECES, VELCRO STICKERS, CRAYONS WHAT YOU DO:

- Print the activity sheet and cut out the armor. Color the activity sheet.
- Explain that we want to dress the man in armor, the same way that God dresses us in his armor
- You will do that by placing a velcro sticker on the back of each armor piece and its back side to the correct place on the activity sheet
- Explain that they will have to listen closely in order to know where to place the stickers onto the activity sheet

WHAT YOU SAY:

- What does a solider put on his head, A helmet, that's right! And what does the helmet do? It protects his head. When we remember that Jesus is our friend forever, it's like we put on a helmet that protects our head. Now everyone put one sticker on the back of your helmet cut out and one on top of the mans head. Now stick the helmet on his head.
- What does the soldier have on his chest? It's his breastplate. God says that when we choose to go His way, it's like we wear a breastplate to protect our heart. Now everyone put a sticker on the back of your breastplate cut out and one on the mans chest. Now stick the breastplate on his chest.
- What is the soldier wearing on his arm? A shield! God says that when we trust Him, it's like we hold up a shield to keep us from getting hurt. Now everyone put a sticker on the back of your shield cut out and one on the mans hand. Now stick the shield on his hand.
- Last is the Bible. The Bible is God's Word. When we read God's Word, it teaches us how to go God's way. Now everyone put a sticker on the back of your bible cut out and the last one on the other hand. Now stick the Bible to his hand!


"With the armor of God, we can always remember that Jesus is our friend, God's way is perfect, and we can always trust Him. Who can trust God? I can trust God."
