

### **CRAFT- HIDING BABY MOSES**

#### WHAT YOU NEED: ACTIVITY PAGE, CUPCAKE LINER, BABY MOSES, COLORING SUPPLIES


#### WHAT YOU DO:

- Cut out baby Moses and print activity page.
- Encourage your child to color the activity sheet.
- Help your child glue Moses into the basket (cupcake liner).
- Then glue the cupcake liner onto the river.


#### WHAT YOU SAY:

"The woman trusted God when she hid her baby, she trusted that God would protect Moses, and guess what? God did protect him! God will protect us too."

### **CRAFT- ASK DEBORAH**

# WHAT YOU NEED: CRAFT TUBE, GREEN TISSUE PAPER, APPLE STICKER, DEBORAH CUT OUT,

- Print out Deborah and encourage your child to color Deborah.
- Once they have colored, instruct them to fold on the solid line so that Deborah can now stand.
- Give your child a piece of green tissue paper.
- Demonstrate how to make the top of the tree by grabbing the paper in the middle and placing it in the top of the *tree*
- Add apple stickers to the tree.
- Reenact the Bible story by placing Deborah under the tree, and have your child ask her questions (just like the story)

#### WHAT YOU SAY:

"In today's story, we heard about a lady named Deborah who was the leader of all God's people. She was their judge. Every day, she would stand under a tree. People would come and ask her what to do. Deborah knew God was with her. She trusted God to help her be wise and tell the people the right thing to do. When God is with you, He helps you be wise and do the right things, too. Who is always with you? **God is always with me.**"

## CRAFT- RAHAB CUP GAME


#### WHAT YOU NEED: 3 CUPS, 3 DOOR AND 6 WINDOW CUTOUTS, RAHAB CUTOUT, COLORING SUPPLIES, GLUE

- Print the activity page and cut out Rahab and encourage your child to color her.
- Once they have finished coloring, assist them in folding the cut out on the line in order to make it stand up.
- Encourage your child to turn their cups upside down and add one door cutout and two window cutouts to each.
- Show children how to play the cup game by putting Rahab under one of the cups, move them around, then guess which "house" she's in

#### WHAT YOU SAY:



# WHAT YOU NEED: ESTHER AND KING CUTOUT, COLORING SUPPLIES, TAPE


#### WHAT YOU DO:

- Print an Esther cut out and a King cut out.
- Encourage your child to color both.
- Help your child wrap the puppet around their finger and using the tape to secure both sides
- Reenact the Bible story using the finger puppets

#### WHAT YOU SAY:

"God is always with us, just like He was with Esther, so we can be strong like she was. Who is always with you? **God is always with me!**"

"He sure is! And you can use your stick figures to tell Esther's story to your friends and family so they will know that God is always with them, too."
