GAME: FEED THE PEOPLE

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Spoon
- Cotton Balls (or Anything That Can Represent Ice Cream)
- Tape (or Anything To Mark Two Points)

WHAT YOU DO:

- Watch KP Online XP.
- Set up two lines using tape, start and finish.
- Place all cotton balls at the start line.
- The object is to get as many ice cream scoops as you can from start to finish.
- balancing one cotton ball on your spoon at a time.
- You have 30 seconds.

CRAFT: ICE CREAM CONE

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Activity Sheet
- Cotton Balls
- Markers or Paint
- Glue

DESCRIPTION:

- Print activity sheet and gather supplies.
- Begin by gluing cotton balls onto ice cream cone.
- Color cotton balls using either paint of markers.
- Allow your child to decorate the activity sheet, if they wish.

RECAP: JOSEPH HELPS PEOPLE

Storyteller: Are you ready to hear the next part of Joseph's story? Do you remember that Joseph was in jail. He was put in jail, even though he'd done nothing wrong. Being in jail was hard for Joseph, but God had a plan. One day, the king of Egypt, Pharaoh, had some dreams he didn't understand. They were about seven cows. Cows? Yep, cows. Can you say "moo" like a cow? So, Pharaoh dreamed about seven cows. Pharaoh also dreamed about stalks of grain. Grain? That's kind of strange. Pharaoh was confused by these dreams, and he wanted to know what his dreams meant. He asked JOSEPH to help him. So, Joseph was brought out of jail straight to Pharaoh. Joseph told Pharaoh that the dreams were from God. Those dreams meant that Pharaoh needed to

save lots and lots of grain, because his people were going to be hungry and need it later. Pharaoh was SO happy to know what his dreams meant, that he gave Joseph a very special job! He put Joseph in charge of ALL of Egypt. Years later, the dreams came true! People were hungry and didn't have food, so they traveled from all over to get grain from Joseph. God's plan for Joseph was to HELP all these people. What an amazing plan! God has a plan for us, too, and God's plan is the BEST plan.

The plans I have for you,' (march)


Says (hands to mouth like yelling)
